Meetings begin at 9:30, followed by a short break Workshops begin after the 15 minute break and usually end around 3:00 PM Dates are subject to change 2022




Per Marge it is OK to send multiple registrations in one envelope \underline{BUT} you must write a separate check to go with each registration form.

I didn't know this so I thought I would share it. If you have completed a painting on canvas do a light spray of flat paint over it. If you use flat paint, it will not show the groves in the canvas.

Another good tip is when you are paint on wood – instead of drilling holes in the wood you can use flat back ½ rounds to hold your hanger on , it them becomes decorative to the painting.

1 lb. of 99% lean ground turkey breast

1 LB 98% lean ground chicken breast

(If you can't find chicken this lean just double the turkey or ask our butcher to ground up some chicken breasts for you, he had no problem doing it for me)

½ cup bread crumbs

½ cup Romano cheese grated

Use the seasonings of your choice but I used garlic power, onion powder, salt and pepper (a great season (everything but the bagel its is also good)

2 eggs

Preheat oven to 400

Hank mix all ing. And form into large balls big enough to fit in a full-size muffin tin (makes 12 /14 balls) you can also make them in the smaller muffin pans and have a lot more.

Bake 20 min

Put them in gravy o sauce you have yourself a meal
